

Scanner Tracker 1.0
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READ ME

Scanner Tracker is a very simple FileMaker Pro® database to help you keep track of what frequencies are programmed into your radio scanner. I originally developed it for my own use because I did not like the way my list looked in Microsoft Excel®. Please note that Scanner Tracker requires that you own a copy of FileMaker Pro®. Scanner Tracker was developed using FileMaker Pro® 5.5, but may work with prior versions, although it is not guaranteed.

Scanner Tracker is very easy to use. When you first open Scanner Tracker, you will see the "Enter Info" tab. This is where you enter all the info about the frequency, including which channel and bank of your scanner it is programmed into, its frequency, PL (if any), what type of system it is (Digital, simplex, etc), and of course, a description.

The "Hits" section of the "Enter Info" tab is for keeping track of which frequencies you have heard chatter on. The "Mark Hit" button will mark the record as "Hit" and will automatically enter the date and time the hit was marked. The day is in standard ISO format "YYYYMMDD" and the time is standard 24 hour time.

The next tab is the "Full List" tab. This tab shows you a list of all your channels in table form. This is handy for when you are scanning and want to know what you are listening to. Pressing the small button with a red "H" next to each record will mark the record as "hit".

The final tab is self explanatory. Clicking on the about text will send you to the Scanner Tracker web site, available at [<http://www.bermudez.cc/scannertracker>] where you can find the latest version of Scanner Tracker.

I hope you enjoy using Scanner Tracker, and that it makes your scanning that much easier. Happy Hunting!

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
